ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Bus Transportation

We have a limited-stop activity bus providing transportation to and from the Orono School's main campus.

- Bus transportation is available Monday Thursday, June 17 - August 8. There is no bus June 19
- Available from designated stops to the main campus for programs beginning at 9 AM.
- Available from the main campus back to designated stops for programs ending at 12 PM and 4 PM.
- Students who are registered for the Summer Playground Program (Rainbow or Holbrook Park) may ride the bus for free from the main campus.
